- 2. DR. S.S. SIDHU ACADEMIC AWARD: Dr. S.S. Sidhu Award was instituted in the year 2013. It is awarded for the published research work in the field of Orthodontics and Maxillofacial Orthopedics by a clinical investigator.
- 3. DR. VINOD KUMAR BHARGAVA ACADEMIC AWARD: This award is instituted in the year 2013 through a donation by Dr. Vinod Kumar Bhargava, FAMS for published research work in the field of Clinical Pharmacology/Drug Development in India by a biomedical scientist below the age of 45 years.
- 4. DR.
