Sub.: Recognition/approval of Guru Gobind Singh Medical College, Faridkot for the award of MBBS degree granted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot against the increased intake i.e. from 50 to 100 seats u/s 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956- req.

I am directed to inform you that the assessments to assess the standard of examination held by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot and to assess the physical and the other teaching facilities available for recognition/approval of Guru Gobind Singh Medical College, Faridkot for the award of MBBS degree granted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot against the increased intake i.e. from 50 to 100 seats u/s 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956 were carried out by the Council assessors on (08.12.2017) and (29th & 30th January, 2018). The assessment reports were considered by the Executive Committee at its meeting held on 06.02.2018 and it was decided as under:-

"The Executive Committee of the Council considered the assessment reports(08thDecember, 2017 and 29th& 30thJanuary, 2018) and decided to recommend to the Central Government for recognition/approval of Guru Gobind Singh Medical College, Faridkot for the award of MBBS degree granted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot against the increased intake i.e. from 50 to 100 seats u/s 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Executive Committee further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Sections 8(3)(2), 8(3)(3) & 8(3)(4) of the Establishment of Medical Colleges Regulations (Amendment), 2010 (Part II) dated 16th April 2010 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

8 (3) ...

(2) The recognition so granted to an Undergraduate Course for award of MBBS degree shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.

(3) The procedure for 'Renewal' of recognition shall be same as applicable for the award of recognition.

(4) Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause (a) supra shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Undergraduate Course of MBBS at the said institute."

The above decision of the Executive Committee has been approved by the Oversight Committee on 23.02.2018.

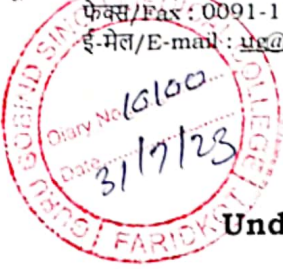

Subject: Continuation of Recognition of MBBS degree (100 seats) granted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot in respect of the students being trained at Guru Govind Singh Medical College, Faridkot, Punjab.

Sir,

I am directed to say that your college was assessed by the Assessors appointed by MARB to conduct physical verification of the facilities, hospital OPD, bed occupancy, etc. on 8th February, 2023. The report of virtual assessment is not available with the UGMEB. The physical assessment report was considered in the Undergraduate Medical Education Board, an autonomous Board of the Commission.

2. While evaluating the assessment report alongwith the AEBAS and HMIS data including CCTV, following was observed:

Deficiency in Faculty and Resident as observed on AEBAS record:

Total working days assessed: 08

The faculty and Senior Resident Doctor deficiency is calculated on the basis of attendance of registered persons by the college on AEBAS records. The attendance of these faculty is ranging from zero to less than 50% of the total working days.

Out of 204 persons registered, 45 have zero attendance and 62 have less than 50% attendance.

3. After careful consideration, it has been decided by the Under Graduate Medical Education Board (UGMEB) that Guru Govind Singh Medical College, Faridkot, Punjab is granted one year recognition to the MBBS qualification with the direction to the college authorities to rectify the shortcomings/deficiencies mentioned above.

4. Accordingly, the approval of the competent authority in UGMEB is hereby conveyed for grant of **CONTINUATION OF RECOGNITION FOR ONE YEAR** for MBBS degree for 100 students, awarded by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot in respect of the students being trained at Guru Govind Singh Medical College, Faridkot, Punjab.

5. You are also directed to fulfill all the deficiencies mentioned above and advised to apply afresh to UGMEB in 2024 for Continuation of Recognition, at least six (6) months prior to the final examination of MBBS Part-II (Practical) along with the requisite fee i.e. Rs. 3.54 lakhs only.

Subject: Reservation for Economically Weaker Section (EWS) for admission in Medical Education Institutions under Constitution Amendment (One Hundred and Third Amendment) Act, 2019 dated 12.01.2019- **Increase/decrease of seats, which was earlier increased under EWS Quota for the academic year 2019-20- Reg.**

Madam/Sir,

In continuation to this Department's letter of even number dated 21.06.2019, I am directed to refer to the BoG-MCI's letter No.MCI-34(41)(EWS)/2019-Med./126765-66 dated 29th June, 2019 submitting revised proposal to the Ministry containing the names of Medical Colleges with permitted MBBS seats and decrease of seats in certain cases which were earlier increased vide Ministry's letter dated 21.06.2019 under EWS quota for 2019-20.

2. After carefully considering the matter, **Ministry of Health & Family Welfare has accepted the proposal of the BoG-MCI and hereby directs the Counselling Authorities (States/UTs/AIQ) for filling up the newly created MBBS seats under EWS quota as per rules in forthcoming academic year 2019-20 mentioned in attached Table A and also directs to delete the seats in certain cases which were earlier increased vide Ministry's letter dated 21.06.2019 mentioned in attached Table B. 
